ABOUT a long-block engine

The long-block is a partly assembled engine. The major components of the engine are pre-assembled. The long-block engine is built in compliance with the serial number of the customer's previous engine. Only the conversion of some external parts from the old engine to the long-block engine needs to be done.

WHY a long-block engine?



IMPORTANT

The parts to be converted from the old engine must be checked carefully.

Damage to the engine due to poor quality or broken parts from the old engine is not covered by warranty.

When some of the external parts from your old engine need replacement, Hamofa can provide a quote on these parts, whether new, used or reconditioned.
